POTENTIAL DUTIES + RESPONSIBILITIES

Assisting with departures in the UK, loading the coaches and supervising the coach out to resort. Alternatively, you may help with preparation in resort including the organization of client packs and resort supplies.



- Pre-trip communication with the group.
- Taking clients to their first lessons and resort orientation.
- Liaising with groups on social activities in and around the resort.
- Night duty to ensure the safety of all clients in the evening.
- Working our larger scale events and festivals such as Rise Festival, or WE trips.
- Assisting at in-resort events both on and off piste.
- Being on hand throughout the entire week to assist clients and answer any questions using our Wasteland app for guidance.
- Running departures from resort and making sure everyone gets back to the UK safely.
- Full days and nights off each week.
- Daily room rounds using our bespoke room round system and app to ensure all guests are fully informed.
- Distribution of keys and lift passes, liaising with Pre-Fitted our equipment partners to assist with hire collection.

1 Finish reading this document and complete the online application form

2 Applications will be assessed by our head office recruitment team over summer

3 You will be informed via email of the outcome of your application in due course

4 You will receive an invite to attend our outstanding Training and Selection weekend

5 Attend our fully comprehensive Training and Selection weekend 2020 - 2021

6 Head office will rigorously test all attendees and you will be informed if you are successful

7 Successful applicants join the Wasteland Ski family!



TRAINING & SELECTION

Attendance at the training weekend is compulsory if you want to rep for us this season.

Our training weekend is also a selection process and only the best applicants will be placed in resort. Successful reps will be informed by the end of November, from there they are offered work throughout the season.

If you are unable to attend the selection and our in person training session at the end of November, we will be holding a secondary event in February. Please reply to your invitation stating to postpone your selection, if unable to attend.

FAQ'S

CAN I WORK A FULL SEASON WITH THE TRAVEL COLLECTIVE?

Each rep must be available for a minimum of two weeks during the season, one in Dec/Jan and the other in March/April. We take into account previous resort experience, but allocations are based on a variety of factors such as UK location vs university base. You will be able to select these online at a later date.

DO I NEED TO BE ABLE TO SKI OR SNOWBOARD TO WORK FOR YOU?

We require a basic level of competence in either Skiing or Snowboarding to work for us, this is due to some of the tasks during the week being based on the slopes. If you would rather have an office or event-based role please keep an eye out for the WE Events recruitment drive (our in-house Large scale event and festival company).

WILL CORONAVIRUS IMPACT MY ABILITY TO WORK AND TRAVEL THIS SEASON?

Whilst we cannot predict the impact of Coronavirus or any 'secondary waves' we are **planning** to run our season as normally as possible. We are following both the UK and French government advice as well as adhering to any advice from the FOC. In addition to this, all clients and staff will be looked after and repatriated if any sanctions are imposed on travel whilst abroad.

As a company we take the safety of our clients and employees very seriously, ensuring all safe and best practises are adhered to following guidance set out by WHO & governments.

I HAVE A FULL-TIME JOB/ UNIVERSITY COURSE, WILL I BE ABLE TO FIT IN TIME IN THE MOUNTAINS?

In short, Yes! The majority of our rep team have other jobs or are full time students. They manage to work not only our peak weeks but on average our reps work 3+ weeks a season. After the training weekend, you select which weeks you are free to work and we allocate accordingly.
